Biography

Graham Munneke is a consultant interventional radiologist at University College London Hospitals. Graham is the past chairman of the research and registries committee of the British Society of Interventional Radiology. He has been a special advisor to NICE for radio-embolisation and was a member of the NHS England Commissioning through evaluation SIRT committee.

Graham is the author of several peer-reviewed papers and has lectured at National and International level on targeted oncological therapies.
